




Notices for remote control

Function Introduction

1. HOME page

Touch the song to enter music play page. Touch "N" or "N" to play the last or next song. Touch "II" to play or pause the song. Touch the bottom and right icons to enter different item pages including Hard disk, U disk, TF card, NAS, Roon, Category,



Favorite, App, Search and Settings. On the right bottom, touch "←" to go back to last step, "☆" to directly go back to HOME page, and "≔" to menu.

2. Hard disk (please prepare a hard disk by yourself)

- (2) The icons on horizontal top show the directory access levels. Single press cango into its interface, press Return can go back to upper level directory.




5. NAS

- (3) Click Add in the upper right corner to add a server manually. Enter the server name and IP address according to the server requirements. If you need an account and password, enter the corresponding account and password.
- (4) When there is a history of access, you only need to click on the last visited server to browse and play server songs as a folder.



6. Category

- (1) Enter the category page, you need to scan local songs for the first time. You can select ALL scanning or specified folder scanning. After the scanning is finished, you can choose 4 categories (single album singer style) to enter the corresponding list to play songs.
- (2) The Singles page displays all locally scanned songs.
- (3) The Album page display local songs according to the album classification, click the entry to enter the corresponding album song list page.
- (4) The Singer page display local songs according to the artist classification, click the entry to enter the corresponding artist song list page.
- (5) The Style page display local songs according to the style classification, click the entry to enter the corresponding style song list page.



7. Favorite

Go to Favorite interface and select corresponding songs to play. (Need hard disk, U disk or TF card, and add favorite for the songs before they can show up on this list)



8. APP

Go to APP interface, it shows the installed App, click to use the APP. (Applications can be installed through Dangbei Market, only for domestic market.)




9. Search (support hard disk, U disk or TF card)

- (1) Keep your mobile phone on normal working status with internet access.
- (2) Scan the QR code to download the App and install it.

For Android system, please go to Google Play App and search "Tonewinner" to download and install the App (the black one). For IOS system, please go to Apple Store App and search "Tonewinner" to download and install the App (the black one).

- (3) The mobile phone and the machine need to be connected to the same WiFi, and the machine can be controlled through the mobile app on the same WiFi.
- (4) You can finish the operations and switches on your mobile phone.

Equipment Safety Standard: Class II

- 5. Do not frequently turn it on or off. Wait a few minutes before turning it on again.
- 6. When the equipment fails, contact with the product managers where you buy this machine for internal maintenace. To avoid accident, do not open the rear cover for inspection or repair.
- 7. The plugs, power lines, fuses, power switch, and transformer used on the equipment are all safety parts. Upon change of safety parts, the maintenance department should replace them in accordance with the model and specification specified by our company.
